TERMS AND CONDITIONS

WWF'S CODE OF COMPETITION CONDUCT

- 1. The competition is open to all UK schools that are signed up and taking part in WWF's Earth Hour 2017.
- 2. The deadline for receiving entries to the competition is 5pm on Monday 27th March 2017.
- 3. Only entries that comply with all entry instructions will be accepted.
- 4. Competition entries must be submitted via Facebook, Twitter or Instagram and using the hashtag #EarthHourStories
- 5. An adult representative from the school must submit the competition entry and by doing so agrees and accepts:
 - i. these terms and conditions:
 - ii. that WWF-UK may publish competition entries both in print and online, including on their websites, social media channels, and for PR purposes;
 - iii. that the winning school may be invited to participate in publicity arising from this competition.
- 6. WWF takes no responsibility for late entries, or entries not successfully posted.
- 7. Entries must be the original work of the school and not copied from any other source.
- 8. The decision of the judges is final and at the absolute discretion of WWF's panel. No correspondence will be entered into.
- 9. The winning school will receive a visit and talk from Rod Downie, WWF's Polar Programme Manager, on a mutually arranged date that is convenient to both parties plus a WWF polar bear adoption for the relevant class or school.
- 10. The winning school will be contacted by email or telephone. If the winning school cannot be contacted after reasonable attempts have been made, WWF reserves the right to offer the prize to another competition entrant.

- 11. WWF reserves the right to cancel this competition without notice at any stage if it is deemed necessary at the absolute discretion of WWF or where events beyond its control prevent proper administration of the competition.
- 12. The competition is administered by WWF-UK.
- 13. These terms and conditions and any disputes arising out of them shall be governed by and construed in accordance with English law.
