

A FEW KEY TIPS

► Watering regularly is the key to successful growing. (But some plants don't like too much – read the instructions). If you are growing things in pots, like lettuce, remember pots will dry out quicker.

▶ Don't let your plants go to seed if you want to keep harvesting them – make sure you nip off the buds and newly formed flowering parts.

► Sow in small batches every week to ensure a continuous supply and to avoid gluts.

► Started late? In a hurry to get going? Buy young plants rather than starting with seeds. Raspberries Beware, they can spread easily and take over your garden.

Fresh mint is lovely to have, but it is prone to take over, consider growing it

Sweetcorn Hard to get them to be ready to harvest before summer holidays.
