What you need

- Hole punch (or knitting needle)


Instructions

- 1. Print out your mask template.
- 2. Stick the template to some card (We find an old cereal box works well!)
- 3. Cut around your mask remember to cut out the eye holes!
- 4. Punch holes (or use a knitting needle) where the black circles are marked and add some string or elastic to keep your mask in place.
- 5. Decorate your mask using colourful crayons, paint or marker pens. You might choose to use some colourful tissue paper or recycled fabric to make it wonderfully unique!
- 6. Why not add whiskers with pipe cleaners or curly paper?
- 7. Now, let us hear you roar!
