

## RECYCLED **ELEPHANT LANTERN**








What you need

- Milk bottle
- Tissue paper
- Pens
- Strong glue
- PVA glue

## What to do

- Wash out a used milk bottle
- Cut around the top of the milk bottle where the handle meets the bottle at the base of the handle.
- 3. Use different coloured tissue to add colour to the elephant with PVA glue.
- 4. Out of the remaining milk bottle cut out two elephant ear shapes. Glue these to the milk bottle using strong glue; you may need to ask an adult to help you.





6. Place over an LED candle and turn the lights off to see your beautiful elephant shining out in the darkness.
