WHAT IS A VIRTUAL LOBBY?

This virtual lobby is an opportunity for thousands of people across the country to meet their MPs online to talk about how the UK's recovery from coronavirus could be a green recovery which benefits people and our planet. This lobby is also the first of its kind so why not join us and make history?

WHY NOW?

"As we build back from the current health crisis, we can choose to tackle climate change and nature's decline, and rebuild a resilient economy that benefits everyone in society. Or we can let the moment for change pass us by, go back to old ways and wait for new crises to hit.

We need to tell politicians that #TheTimeIsNow to put a healthy, greener, fairer future at the heart of plans to rebuild a strong economy".

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WHAT DO I NEED TO DO TO GET INVOLVED?



1. Sign up as the lead contact for your class

2. Write to your MP to let them know that you are attending
