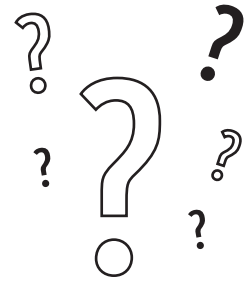


FUNDRAISE YOUR WAY!



QUIZ NIGHT

**There's nothing like a little friendly competition to get your fundraiser going!
Make your quiz questions general or themed – it's up to you!**

What you need

- Your quiz questions – consider doing rounds of themed questions or make it more generalised. There are lots of WWF quizzes on wwf.org.uk, or on our YouTube channel, to help you get started
- A quiz master – this could be yourself or a friend or family member
- A date, time and location (though a location is not needed if you're holding your quiz virtually)
- Invitations to your quiz. There are printable invites on our website or invite friends and family by WhatsApp or email. Decide if you want people to take part in groups or as individuals
- If you're holding this event in person, you'll need paper and pens for each team, so they can record their answers

What you need to do

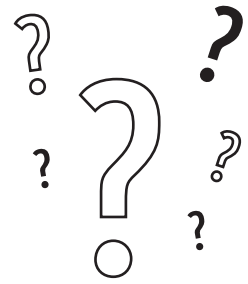
- To fundraise, charge your quizzers to enter the quiz. You could charge per person (e.g. £5) or a set amount per team. You can collect this money in person or on a JustGiving page.



TOP TIP!
Consider doing some small 'add-on' fundraising at your quiz. Host a raffle or run a cake sale for extra donations

FUNDRAISE YOUR WAY!



- On the day, make sure you have all your questions ready. Depending on how you want to score your quiz, you may want to consider a scoreboard showing the highest scorer after each round, or you could add up all the scores at the end to find out the winner
- Take your time on each round and ask your quizzers if they need any questions repeated – they'll really appreciate this

Tips and ideas

- Quizzes can be held virtually on an online streaming site, such as Tiltify, or on Facebook, Zoom or WhatsApp. Consider writing joining instructions for friends and family who may not be confident with these platforms
- Take a break halfway through your quiz to give people a chance to stretch their legs. This is a great time to remind everyone why you've chosen to fundraise in aid of WWF
- Remember, the quizmaster is always right!
