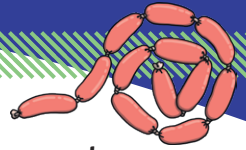

Many people on our planet eat a lot of meat and dairy products (milk, cheese, yoghurt) that come from animals. Farms that produce these things need lots of space, water and food for the animals, which also needs to be grown and uses up more land and water.



How could people change their ways to make farming better for the planet?

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Lots of plastic waste makes its way into the sea every year.

This can harm creatures living there.



What can people do to reduce the amount of plastic that gets into the oceans?

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Lots of species (types) of plants and animals in jungles and rainforests need each other so they can survive. If just one species goes extinct (disappears forever), it can also cause problems for other species.



What must people do to protect plants and animals in jungles and rainforests?

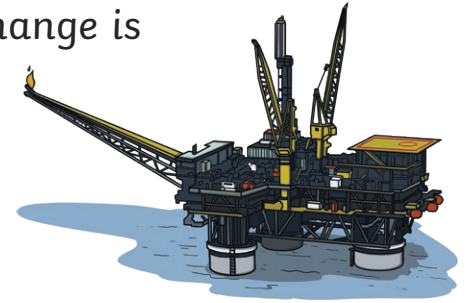
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When people spend time outside in green spaces like parks and forests, it can help them to feel happy and is good for their health.



How can we make sure that everyone can find a green space close to where they live?

A big reason for climate change is fossil fuels (oil, coal and natural gas) being used to make a lot of the world's energy and fuel.



What could be used instead of fossil fuels to make energy?

Farmers need the land that they farm to make enough money to live on, but when they sell their goods, they don't always get enough.



What can be done so farmers earn enough money to live on?

A forest space the size of a football pitch is cut down every second because of farming or producing wood. This is called deforestation.
