COMPETITION

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. WWF-UK is offering the chance for schools to win an animal adoption pack to celebrate Earth Hour 2022. The competition consists of filling in a form to let us know what your school/class has done, or will do, for Earth Hour this year. Three entries (representing three different schools) will be chosen at random by the Education Team to receive an animal adoption prize.
2. The competition is open to UK Schools only. Only teachers can enter the competition.
3. Only one entry per class is permitted. Multiple entries per school are allowed, however the winning prizes will go to three separate schools.
4. The competition opens on Tuesday 25th January 2022 and closes on Friday 8th April 2022 at 5pm. Any entries received after this time will not be considered.

6. Entry is through the online form only.
7. Any contact details supplied will be used for administering the competition and otherwise in accordance with WWF's data protection policy which can be found at <https://www.wwf.org.uk/privacy-and-data-protection>.
8. WWF-UK accepts no responsibility for late entries, or entries that are lost, mislaid, damaged, or delayed in transit, regardless of cause including as a result of equipment failure, technical malfunction, systems, satellite, network, server or computer hardware or software failure of any kind. Proof of sending does not qualify as proof of receipt.
9. All valid entries received will be entered into a prize draw. Three different schools will be randomly picked as the winners.
10. The three selected schools will be notified by email by 5pm on Friday 29th April 2022. If selected school cannot be contacted after reasonable attempts have been made, WWF-UK reserves the right to offer the animal adoption prize to another entrant school.
11. A representative from the winning school will be able to choose which animal adoption pack they would like to receive (<https://support.wwf.org.uk/adopt-an-animal>)

12. The prize is non-transferrable and cannot be exchanged for the cash equivalent. WWF-UK reserves the right to substitute the prize for an alternative prize of equal or greater value.

13. The decision of the prize draw is in WWF-UK's absolute discretion and any decision is final. No correspondence will be entered into.

14. A representative of the entrant school submits the entry on the school behalf and by doing so accepts:

a) these terms and conditions,

b) that the school and adult representatives of the school may be invited to participate in publicity arising from this competition.

15. WWF-UK reserves the right to cancel or amend the terms of this competition without notice at any stage if it is deemed necessary at the absolute discretion of WWF-UK.

16. The competition is administered by WWF-UK.
