

WWF-UK VOLUNTEER TERMS & CONDITIONS

By signing up to volunteer at a WWF-UK event, you agree to the following terms and conditions:

- You are over the age of 18. If you are under the age of 18 you must be accompanied by a parent or guardian, who is also signed up to volunteer at the event.
- You agree to follow and respect the instructions and guidelines provided by WWF-UK staff and any relevant event organisers.
- You agree to act responsibly and within the law, ensuring you are representing WWF-UK well in your behaviour and actions.
- You understand you are responsible for your own actions or inactions. Where these differ
 from the wishes of the event organiser or WWF-UK team, neither the organiser, WWF-UK, its
 employees or agents can be held responsible for loss or damage to personal effects, injury or
 death.
- You understand you are responsible for any of your personal belongings for the duration of your volunteering and that some events will not have secure areas.
- You agree to keep WWF-UK informed and updated if any circumstances change that mean you are unable to attend or carry out your role.
- You understand WWF-UK may contact you by email, phone, SMS and post in relation to your volunteer role, to allow for successful participation.
- You agree that WWF-UK may use without payment, notice or further consent any photographs, videos and other images in which you appear which are taken at an event by the organiser or their suppliers, our employees or any participant or other person attending. Should you prefer that WWF-UK do not use any such images in which you may appear which are taken at the event in any promotional materials or if you do not wish to be the subject of any photography, please notify us by emailing challenge@wwf.org.uk
