



# EVENT VOLUNTEER FAQs

## Why should I volunteer with WWF?

Every year hundreds of runners, walkers, cyclists, and swimmers take on a challenge to support WWF's work to bring our world back to life. Our dedicated team of event volunteers help to create a memorable experience for everyone taking part and spur our supporters towards the finish line.

## What volunteering roles are available?

Most of our volunteering roles are for our fabulous WWF cheer squads who give an extra loud roar to any runners or riders donning our Team WWF colours. For some events, we also require photographers who are skilled at capturing the moment and massage therapists who can help soothe our participants' aching muscles.

## What will I receive when I volunteer?

As well as the warm fuzzy feeling gained from helping to bring our world back to life, you'll receive WWF branded kit and will have the opportunity to meet new and like-minded people. We usually provide refreshments for our volunteers too.

## How much time do I have to give as a volunteer?

Most of our event day roles are 3-4 hours in duration and are usually offered as early and late shifts. Of course, if you'd like to volunteer for the whole day, that would be greatly appreciated.

## What skills do I need to volunteer?

To help create memorable event experiences for our dedicated supporters, we're on the lookout for friendly, approachable, and energetic volunteers who are always happy to chat. It would be great if you share our passion for nature, conservation, and wildlife.

## What happens after I sign up to volunteer?

Once registered, we'll be in touch to provide a detailed event briefing with information about the event, your role, location, and timings. You'll also receive contact details for the designated event manager should you have any questions or concerns.

## Will I be paid to cover my expenses?

Unfortunately, WWF are unable to reimburse expenses in relation to your volunteering role.
